

RESOLUTION NO. 52

The Board of Aldermen of Golden City, Mo. hereby designates Tuesday, July 27, 1948 as the date of the special election to be held in the city of Golden City, Mo. for the purpose of submitting to the voters of Golden City, Mo. the proposal of granting a franchise to the Golden City Telephone Co. for a period of twenty years.

The ballots to be voted will be in this form:

PROPOSAL

Shall the City of Golden City, Mo. grant a 20-year franchise to the Golden City Telephone Company.

For the proposition

Against the proposition

Voters will mark an "x" in the square indicating their preference.

The voters of ward one will vote in the Herald office.
The voters of ward two will vote in the G.C. Shoe Shop.
The voters of ward three will vote in the City Hall.

The same laws pertaining to municipal elections will prevail at this election.

And a canvass of the votes following the election shall determine the granting of the franchise. Should two-thirds of the vote cast approve the proposal, then it shall have been decided that the franchise shall be granted; should less than a two-third majority be recorder for the proposal, then it shall be deemed to have been defeated.
