

Regular meeting of city council Monday, March 18, 1957,
Mayor Mayers presiding, Aldermen Beckett, Shacklett, Bishop,
Curry, Tucker present. Head absent.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Following bills presented:

Jack McDonald 6 loads gravel at \$9 ... \$54

Motion by Curry 2d Bishop to allow bills. Carried.

Mrs. Evelyn Thieman met with council in regard to insurance
of liability on city pickup truck. Amt is \$461.34. Motion by
Shacklett for her to continue insurance, 2d Tucker. Carried.

Resignation of alderman Fred Head read by mayor, he being from
3rd ward. Motion to accept same by Tucker, 2d Bishop. Carried.

Ald. Shacklett presented need for gravel in street near Morrison
elevator, about two loads that sufficient. Mayor mentioned he plans
to see Norris Grain about their connecting to sewer system, as
with construction of new building it is possible they may be near
enough to sewer lines to demand connection. Motion by Curry to
place gravel as mentioned above. 2d Beckett. Carried.

Motion by Shacklett, 2d by Tucker for the clerk to notify Combs
and Combs, attorneys, to immediately file suit against Clifford
Eike and EHMCGowen to collect the blacktopping due the city. Ald.
Shacklett mentioned if they do not wish to file the suit, to
engage another law firm. They are to be notified by April 1st.
Motion carried.

Mayor informed council he and the marshal received a telegram
from the Governor asking that convalescent and nursing homes be
examined for fire hazard as come under the new law. He called the
governor's office back and they told him such homes were any place
where old folks reside and ~~for him to meet with the county court~~
suggested for him to meet with the county court. He said he went
to Amar and met with the court. The sheriff will do the inspecting
here at Golden City to look over places where old folks reside.
He will contact John Bushnell and Earl Maddie to accompany the
sheriff on this inspection tour.

Motion to adjourn by Shacklett, 2d Tucker. Carried.
