MINUTES

Cassandra Probert motioned Danny Dillon second the motion to accept meeting minutes from March 2nd, 2026, All in favor Motion carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Richard Sprankle addressed the council concerning the sidewalk in front of the building he is constructing on Main Street.

John Carney addressed the council about the mobile home application he has filed with the City.

Rodney Evans motioned Cassandra Probert second the motion to deny the mobile home application.

The property owner can refile the mobile home application in his name if the mobile home is in his name as well. The council is willing to waive the application fee if the property owner wishes to apply.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Zach Renfro addressed the council about the roof on the park building at East Park. There was discussion about the need to replace a lawn mower due to mechanical issues. The drainage issue behind Business Forms on A Street was discussed.

Vicky Jones motioned Rodney Evans second the motion to move forward with drainage repairs with a squish pipe up to \$5500.00. All in favor Motion carried

Eric White addressed the council with the fire report. The Easter egg hunt was discussed as well and whether or not the fire dept would be selling fireworks this year. There was a discussion concerning the new radios the fire dept received from Jasper County and what was needed to make them work properly.

The council discussed the need to remove a few structures that are damaged beyond repair.

There are some large trees in some of the City right of ways that may need to be removed.

There was a discussion about the sidewalk work MODot is going to be doing in town.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The issue of adjusting the rent on the Park building was discussed.

Rodney Evans motions Cassandra Probert second the motion to set the rent at \$50.00 per day and a \$50.00 cleaning deposit would be required. All in favor Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Golden Harvest Days Tractor Pull was discussed to relocate this to the City property by the wastewater plant.

Vicky Jones motioned Rodney Evans second the motion to use the City property for the Golden Harvest Day tractor pull with Harvest Day committee covering the insurance. All in favor Motion carried.

The Heating and Air at City Hall was discussed. The matter is being tabled until the next meeting. More bids for repair will be presented then.

Mediacom has presented City Hall with an offer for a 3-year contract to increase the internet and reduce the monthly bill. This issue was tabled until the next meeting to gather other offers.

MISCELLANEOUS HEARING

There was a discussion on purchasing an extended warranty for the Mini X and the Skid Steer. It was decided to table this until the next meeting to gather information as to what the extended warranty will cover.

There was a discussion concerning the current dog issues that have been occurring in town.

Cassandra Probert motioned Danny Dillon second the motion to pay the bills. All in favor Motion carried.
