Vicky Jones motioned Carla Davis second the motion to release the 2 dogs in holding on Tuesday morning, with the following conditions: Payment of \$60 is to be made to City Hall for pick up fees and 1 day holding fee for each dog, Vaccination records are to be brought to City Hall by Monday 2/9/2026, and dogs are to be removed from town to be relocated to Jasper, MO until she can secure a new residence where they can be contained in accordance with City ordinances. Ordinance 882 was briefly discussed

Ordinance 882 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE II, PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE, ARTICLE II DANGEROUS OR VICIOUS ANIMALS, SECTION 205.160 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN CITY TO MAKE THE DETERMINATION OF A DANGEROUS OR VICIOUS ANIMAL NOT BREED SPECIFIC. This ordinance was discussed and a vote was taken by title only.

The council also discussed equipment for possible City purchase from Heritage Tractor of Lockwood, MO.

The council deliberated the pros and cons of all 3 companies' equipment, financing options, and what would best suit the City's needs.

Carla Davis motioned Danny Dillon second the motion to move forward with Heritage Tractor of Lockwood, MO for the purchase of a mini excavator and skid steer up to \$90,000.00 contingent on approval of 2 absent council members. All in favor Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Park building repairs were discussed. The council has agreed to have the roof looked over to see what repairs are needed to ensure the building is safe from leaks. It was also decided that cosmetic repairs such as painting the ceiling and renovating the display board were approved. The counter top replacement was discussed and pricing will be the determining factor.

The Park Building rent rate was discussed and it was tabled until a future meeting.

The replacement of the Netgear router used at City Hall was discussed and approved.

MISCELLANEOUS HEARING


The council discussed the purchase of a plug for the wastewater plant to flush the outlet of the old clarifier to remove blockages.
